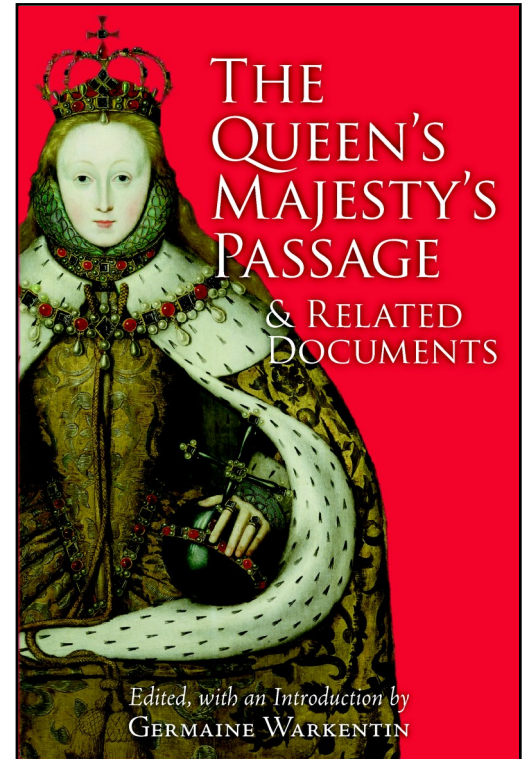


The Queen's Majesty's Passage & Related Documents

In January of 1559, the young Elizabeth Tudor entered London in ceremonial procession, the traditional prelude to coronation at Westminster Abbey. The pamphlet published a few days later (the first virtually complete record of an English royal entry) describes the Queen's progression, the decorations, costumes, poems and songs, ritual presentation of gifts, and the pageants that instructed her in her new role. The circumstances of the procession and the political aftermath of the pamphlet have occupied historians for four centuries—yet there has never been an accurate and fully annotated version of the work available.

This edition presents a scholarly, modernized text, with annotation, illustrations, maps, and appendices of related documents, including the first accurate translation of Aloisio Schivenoglia's letter, describing the event from a Catholic point of view. Also included are textual notes, glossary, and a comprehensive bibliography of relevant scholarship.
